ASSOCIATE BOARD MEMBER ROLES

We ask each member to play an active role on the Associate Board:

- Attend quarterly board meetings
- Play a role in the impact we create: nominate charities for an IICF grant
- Volunteer during Week of Giving
- Actively promote and participate in Associate Board events
- Spread the word: invite colleagues and contacts to join IICF

GUIDELINES FOR MEMBERSHIP

- Up to two individuals from one company can be members at a given time
- There is no financial requirement to join, although we encourage a small annual contribution
- The time commitment varies but we estimate 5-10 hours per month.
- While it's important you remain committed, we recognise you will be busy at certain times
